EDUCATIONAL TOPIC

The Grand Chapter is nearing the end of the 2020-2021 year and the Grand Chapter Membership Committee is working on potential changes and direction we think the Chapters need to move, to improve the training and education of the Chapters. When I visit Chapters for Degree Work, Schools of Instruction, and Inspections, I am finding a common situation. There are newer members than older ones. A probable cause is the reluctance of the older members, who have been the mainstay of the Chapters, to attend meetings. I hope with Covid immunizations and herd immunity many will return and continue their leadership roles.

This brings me to some of the things currently being discussed by the Grand Chapter to improve the ability to learn Degree Work and improve Chapter Practice Sessions. I have 2 following points:

- (A) Creation of a DVD of the four Degrees that would fully explain set-up, movements, and props used in each Degree. I have had Chapters ask to see a perfect Degree and this would be one method to provide a uniform Degree in all Chapters.
- (B) a tactics Book has also been discussed, for use along with the video, as a study guide for the individual Companion.

The Educational Officer for the Chapter can also add to the light and information needed by our new and sometimes younger members, with History and the background of each of the Degrees. That will aid in a bond of appreciation of the work being undertaken in our Degrees. Grand Chapter is seeking feedback to assist us in providing for a proficient work environment in the Chapters.
